Next Week's Speaker...

Tom Delacenserie was appointed by Gov. Matt Bevin as the president and CEO of the Kentucky Lottery Corporation in May 2017.

Tom came to Kentucky from the Florida Lottery, where he served as its secretary and CEO. He assumed that role in 2015, but his work there goes back to 2000 when he started as a district manager. In that time, Delacenserie rose through the ranks in positions such as director of sales and deputy secretary of sales and marketing. In the three completed fiscal years since Tom joined the Kentucky Lottery, sales records have been broken in each.

Tom's presentation will be "Three Decades of the Kentucky Lottery." Back in 1988, Kentucky voters approved a constitutional amendment to allow lottery ticket sales in the Commonwealth. It was sold to voters as a way to help education in Kentucky — but has it lived up to what was expected?

Tom will explain where lottery proceeds have been spent and how they've directly affected Louisville. He'll also address a number of lottery myths and misconceptions, including whether or not you're truly more likely to get struck by lightning than win the lottery!

A Green Bay native and graduate of the University of Wisconsin, Delacenserie spent 28 years in consumer product sales before working in the lottery industry. He worked in sales for companies such as Heinz and Scholl, and in sales management with Parfums de Coeur and Pfizer where he was national accounts manager. Delacenserie has been married to his wife Mary Anne for 46 years, and they have three daughters and two granddaughters.
