• Approved the minutes of the 7/17/19 board meeting. Alex Fitzgerald made the motion, second by Bill Miller.

• Approved the leaves-of-absence for the following Rotarians: Pat Badgett from 7/1/19 to 10/1/19, Angela Bullock from 7/17/19 to 1/17/20 and Kristin Cantrell from 7/31/19 to 8/21/19.

• Acknowledge with regrets resignation of Jennifer Dobbs and Wendy Kobler.

• Listened to Financial report for July 2019 as presented by John Avent.

• Approved amendments to the proposed budget for 2019-20. Fred Deaton made the motion, second by Dustin Cole.

• Membership report was given by Mary Saks for Maree Barney-Sutley. She reported that the membership committee met and came up with three factors: 1.) How to attract members, 2.) How to keep members engaged in Rotary and 3.) How to get new members participating in Rotary. The committee is in the process of making a tri-fold brochure with Rotary information that can be handed out to prospective new members.
