Franklin County Sheriff **Chris Quire** was born and raised in Franklin County where he went to school and now resides with his wife and two children. In 2000, former Sheriff Ted Collins hired Quire as a bailiff to work in the courts, while he also worked in parking enforcement for the Frankfort Police Department; later, he was hired as a patrol deputy. Sheriff Quire ultimately transferred to the Frankfort Police Department as a patrol officer and worked his way through the ranks to captain. Sheriff Quire was elected to office and was sworn in January 2019. Sheriff Quire's motto is "Service is our Duty," and believes that working together with other agencies is key to better serving the citizens of Franklin County.

A few side notes about Sheriff Quire's family: his wife Kendra is also in community service and has been a teacher in our local schools since 2001; Quire's son Campbell, 15, is also

a young business owner, owning a successful blacktop sealing business called Quire's Sealcoating; and Quire's daughter Kendall, 11, enjoys school and softball and regularly helps aid the animals at the Franklin County Humane Society.
