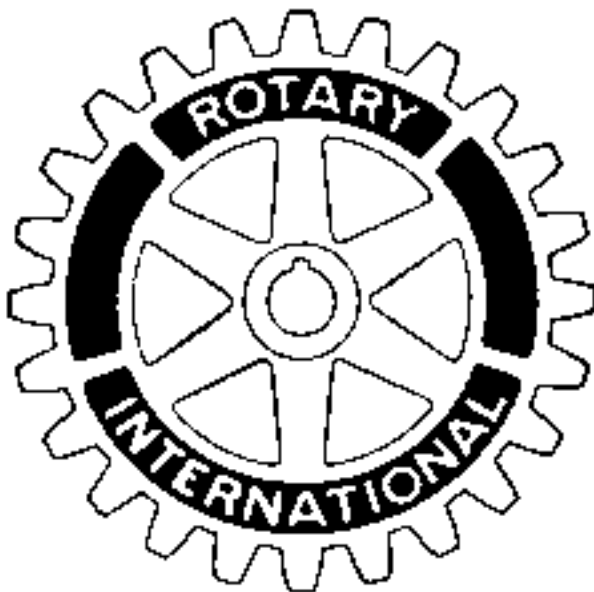

- Approved the minutes of the Dec. 18, 2019 board meeting with amendment: the word "purposed" should have been "proposed." Fred Deaton made the motion, second by Dustin Cole.
- Acknowledged with regrets letter of resignation from fellow Rotarian Bill Leroy.
- Listened to Financial Report for December 2019 as presented by John Avent.
- Vocational Service Director Dustin Cole reports that he is working on getting a committee together to talk about the club taking over the "Faith & Freedom" project.
- President Fred reported that he has spoken to Kristin Cantrell on the "Radio Fundraiser

Project" and that it will need to get starting in March or April.

- Approved new member Mitchell Wilson contingent upon no negative response after publication in the newsletter. Maree Barney-Sutley made the motion, second by John Avent.
