- Approved the minutes of the January 15, 2020 board meeting. Donna Hecker made the motion, second by Alex Fitzgerald.
- Approved leaves-of-absence for Pat Badgett from 1/1/20 to 6/30/20 and Teresa Hockensmith from 2/26/20 to 3/11/20. Alex Fitzgerald made the motion, second by Donna Hecker.
- Approved new members Sonia Sanders and Dr. M. Christopher Brown II contingent upon no negative response after publication

in the newsletter. Alex Fitzgerald made the motion, second by Dustin Cole.

- Listened to Financial Report for January 2020 as presented by John Avent.
- Approved reimbursement to Paula Rarden for \$89.99 for the cost of a new printer. Dustin Cole made the motion, second by Alex Fitzgerald.
