Our guest speakers for the Zoom meeting will be **Delvin Azofeifa** (Ah-So-Fay-Fa). and **Louis Mitchell**.

Although one of the founding members of Frankfort BlueBackers, Azofeifa does not have a background in law enforcement, but rather the

education of kids who often interact with law enforcement. Working with at-risk kids both in and out of the classroom for over 14 years, he has often been an intermediary between children, parents, and the juvenile justice system. Originally from Louisville, he graduated from Southern High School with a 1.6 GPA, then earned a B.A. in Social Science from Morehead State University with a 3.4 GPA, an M.A. in Educational Leadership from West Virginia University with a 3.9 GPA, and an M.A. in Special Education from Kentucky State University. Delvin currently teaches Job Skills, Government, and History at Martin Luther King Academy for Excellence in Lexington.

Frankfort native **Louis Mitchell** graduated from Frankfort High School in 1982. He served four years in the U.S. Air Force, then finished his Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice at Kentucky State University. After working for state government and serving in the Kentucky Army National Guard, Louis was hired by the Federal Bureau of Investigation in 1996. After serving 22½ years with the FBI Miami Division, Louis and his wife Kathryn retired back to Frankfort. Louis also has a Master's Degree in Diplomacy from Norwich University in Vermont.
