Adams has served with FPD since 1999. He holds a bachelor's degree in police administration and a master's in law enforcement, both from Eastern Kentucky University. During his tenure with the FPD, Chief Adams has completed the Department of Criminal Justice Training's Academy of Police Supervision, Criminal Justice Executive Development, and was the FPD's first office to complete the Kentucky Leadership Institute's School of Strategic Leadership. Chief Adams is also an alumnus of the Federal Bureau of Investigations National Academy.

When he took over as Frankfort Police Chief in January 2019, he said it was a "dream come true." He and his wife Becky have three children.
