Fellow Rotarian, art educator and professional award-winning visual artist **Sallie Clay Lanham** will be our speaker next week. Since graduation from the Art Academy of Cincinnati she has been an elementary and college teacher, leader in many community projects like the Kings Center, Grand Theater, children art camps, visual arts programs, fundraiser for the Women's Shelter, and others. Director of several Rotary community projects. She was co-editor of the book "Portrait of Early Families of Frankfort before 1860." Her great-grandmother was a national and statewide leader in the suffrage movement, which leads to today's program about 12 other Kentucky women that fought for women's right to vote. Kentucky was the 24th state to ratify the 29th amendment, which states, "The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex" on Jan. 6, 1920.
