I have been in communication with the District Governor, Bob Vaughn, of District 6840. They are devastated. They are in need of financial aid which can be accomplished by going to <https://secure.qgiv.com/for/hir/>. They are also in need of the following list of items to help stabilize the area: tarps, roofing nails, personal hygiene kits, MRE's, insect spray, and first aid supplies. There are several districts that are sending their disaster relief teams as the days move forward.

“We can help now by giving of our treasures and assisting with our time and talents when the moments are available in the future. In addition to all this, District 6190 has connected with Life Flight. Linda Thomas at [thomasblessed50@gmail.com](mailto:thomasblessed50@gmail.com) will coordinate efforts to move in critical supplies. They are willing to come and pick up critical emergency items (no water or fuel) and volunteers coming into or out of the disaster area.

A little closer to home, Waverly, Tennessee is situated in our neighboring District 6760 and was deluged with 17 inches of rain, resulting in an historic flooding event. DG Story continues, “I have received correspondence from District
