Attending: Diane Dehoney, Bill Miller, Gary Stratton, Carol Smith, Andrew Kent, Gordon Saks, Mary Saks, John Avent, Chuck Dickinson, Lee Troutwine, Alex Fitzgerald and Paula Rarden.

- Approved the minutes of the September 15, 2021 board meeting. John Avent made the motion, second by Bill Miller.
- Approved leave-of-absences for Dudley Ellis from 9/17/21 to 1/1/22, Brenda Rice and Tom Utterback from 11/1/21 to 4/1/22. Gordon Saks made the motion, second by Gary Stratton.
- Listened to the September 2021 financial report from John Avent.
- International Service Director, Bill Miller provided an update on the following three items: the Rotary Club of Oakland and Club

Rotario Guatemala Del Este global grant on Rabinal Guatemala; the co-sponsorship by the Frankfort and Louisville Rotary Clubs and the two Rotary Districts in Kentucky in support of the United Nations Day program on Human Trafficking and Plastic Pollution on October 26; and the cost of the International Dinner on April 28, 2022. Table vote on the meeting venue until next board meeting.

- Approved the disbursement of the budgeted \$500 to go to the Humanitarian Project. Bill Miller made the motion, second by Chuck Dickinson.
- President-Elect Gary Stratton reported that the joint meeting with the Kiwanis will be 11/24/21 and will have a lunch catered in for the meeting.
- Alex Fitzgerald reported on the club changing over to a 501(c)(3). The filing fees for this change would cost around \$640 and a 26-page document must be filed at that time. No action was taken and was tabled to a later date.
- Sergeant-at-arms Director Chuck Dickinson is still working with Dave Weller to get a projector working for the club speakers to use.
- Youth Service Director, Andrew Kent noted he will be in attendance for the FRYF visionary meeting on 11/19/21.
