Next Week's Meeting...

Garth L. Vinson's diverse background started when he was born and raised on a dairy farm in rural Pennsylvania. He received his draft notice in 1971 but enlisted to get training in aviation which had been his dream. The Army was the only service that would guarantee that training. Garth's service with the Army included a tour of duty in South Korea and two tours in Germany. He was given assignments of increasing responsibility culminating to being the only Non-Commissioned Officer in charge of a Research and Development section in the Army's 160th



Special Operations Aviation Regiment. He retired from active service in 1992 as a Master Sergeant. Wanting to continue his education Garth enrolled at Murray State University. After 10 years of doing experimental electronics, he completed a Bachelor's and Master's Degree in Horticulture. Due to the untimely passing of the Horticulture Professor Garth ended up teaching for two years while running the Kentucky Department of Agriculture Vineyard Assistance Program. This program helped launch 27 vineyards and wineries in Kentucky. In 2001 Garth was recruited to come to Frankfort to be the Landscape Branch Manager/Horticulturist for the Department of Facilities and Support Services, Finance and Administration Cabinet. Garth oversaw all outside maintenance for 41 state facilities including buildings from Ashland to Madisonville, the old and new State Capitol buildings, the Governor's Mansion and the Floral Clock. He retired in 2017. In 2015 along with his lovely wife, Carol, Garth started, and continues to operate, NextHome Custom Realty located at 1801 Louisville Rd. here in Frankfort.
