Wayne Briscoe is the fire chief of the City of Frankfort Fire and EMS Department. Before his appointment as chief, Briscoe had been the assistant fire chief, managing the Operations Division of the department after rising through the ranks as firefighter, sergeant, lieutenant, captain, battalion chief, and EMS director. He began his firefighting career with the Anderson County Fire District in July of 1994 as a Junior firefighter before being hired with the City of Frankfort Fire and EMS Department in 2002.

Chief Briscoe has earned an Associate of Science in Applied Fire Science, a Bachelor of Science in Fire Administration, and achieved his Executive Fire Officer certification from the National Fire Academy in 2020. Chief Briscoe currently serves as President for the Central Kentucky Fire Chiefs Association, 2nd Vice President of the Kentucky Fire Chiefs Association (KAFC), and has served in an

active role during the last two legislative sessions while serving on the KAFC legislative committee. While not actively appointed to any formal board or committee position, Chief Briscoe actively monitors the actions of the Kentucky Board of EMS (KBEMS) to ensure the best interests of the Kentucky Fire Service are taken into consideration.
