**Heather Housman**, president of the Woods and Waters Land Trust, grew up in Western Kentucky spending as much time as possible outdoors. She received a BS in Natural Resource Conservation and Management and an MS in Forest Ecology from the University of Kentucky. Her graduate work focused on the forests of the Cumberland Plateau and included entomology. With the exception of a few months at the Division of Air Quality promulgating regulations, she has spent most of her career continuing to spend as much time as possible outdoors working for LFUCG (Lexington) Parks & Recreation and

the Kentucky Nature Preserves Commission. She is an author of articles in Forest Ecology and Management and Journal of the Torrey Botanical Society, as well as Kentucky's Natural Heritage: An Illustrated Guide to Biodiversity. She lives with her husband Rex and their daughter Sarah on the banks of Elkhorn Creek in Franklin County. Heather served on the Board of Directors of WWLT from 2007 to mid-2018, rejoining in 2019. She is on the Executive Committee, Performance Excellence Committee, Conservation Committee, and the Fundraising Committee.
