- Approved the minutes of the Jan. 26, 2022, board meeting. Bill Miller made the motion, second by Gary Stratton.
- Listened to financial report for January 2022 as presented by John Avent.
- Community Service Director Sonia Sanders reported that she plans to attend

In-person Meetings Resume

Beginning with next week's meeting on March 2, we will return to in-person meetings at the Capital Plaza Hotel.

the Lawrenceburg Rotary pancake breakfast on Saturday (Feb. 26) to be held at Emma Ward Elementary. She also shared that the Frankfort Kiwanis pancake breakfast will be held March 12.

- Vocational Director Calen Studler reported his findings on the possibility of hosting a 5K as a fundraiser later in the year, including a list of the 5Ks currently scheduled by other Frankfort organizations. He suggested a more rural race route, perhaps utilizing the mountain bike trail at West Sixth Farm.
- International Service Director Bill Miller noted that the District's Rabinal, Guatemala grant received enough funding and closed early, before we were able to donate the \$500 we had set aside. We will hold onto these funds for another international project next year, with the possibility of adding to it if the budget permits.
- International Service Director Bill Miller also reported that in searching for a speaker for the April 28 International Dinner, the committee became concerned with achieving a good turnout due to COVID concerns; also, an increase in prices from the country club. Suggested cancelling the International Dinner for this year but noted we will still need to fulfill our \$1,500 commitment to Polio Plus.
- Approved asking members for a \$25 voluntary contribution toward Polio Plus and hosting a silent auction at the April 27 meeting in place of this year's International Dinner. John Avent made the motion, second by Gordon Saks.
- Public Relations Director Donna Hecker reported that she dropped off packets for the March 2 speech contest to all local high schools and will pick up applications on Friday. She will need members to serve as judges, timekeepers, and scorers for the speech contest. Our budget allotted \$326 for

the contest prizes, but she suggested we raise this amount to the \$600 recommended by the district.

- Approved using \$150 from literacy project and \$124 from general fund to reach the suggested \$600 recommended by the district for speech contest prizes. Gary Stratton made motion, second by Andrew Kent.
- Membership Director Carol Smith reported a new member application from Chanda Veno. She asked for those who haven't already voted via email to please do so. She also shared that she has been following up with the speakers each week regarding membership, and she suggested that we host a membership challenge for next quarter (each member who sponsors a new applicant will be entered into a \$50 cash drawing). President Diane and Gary Stratton will donate the prize money.
- Program Coordinator Gary Stratton noted that he is currently booking March and April programs. March 30 will be a club assembly.
- Gary Stratton will also contact Kristin Cantrell in hopes of hosting our Radio Days fundraiser during the month of April.
- President Diane noted that we will move discussion of scheduling a meeting at Jim's Seafood to the March board meeting when Secretary Paula Rarden is in attendance with further details.
- President Diane will contact the District RYLA Chair to schedule a meeting with her and Youth Services Director Andrew Kent to see what we need to do to share the opportunity with our school systems.
- President Diane reported that she met earlier in the week with President-Elect Dustin Cole and Gary Stratton to further discuss our club's centennial events. Dustin and Tish Shade will co-chair a committee in charge of what we are tentatively calling the "Rotary Freedom Fest" to be held the weekend leading up to July 4th that will include music, vendors, booths, etc.

President Diane and Gary will co-chair a city-wide day of service the following Saturday (July 9) when our club will come together to work on a service project and invite all the other civic organizations in town to do the same. Dustin is scheduling a meeting with the city to find out about dates, permits, etc. and will report back. President Diane challenged all board members to join one of these committees and will be sending out an email soon with more committee details. More information will be shared with the club at the upcoming club assembly.

- President Diane shared that she will be attending the District Presidents' meeting tomorrow evening (Feb. 24).
- Scheduled the next board meeting for March 16.
