Author **Chris Helvey** spent his childhood in Missouri and Arkansas before migrating to Williamsburg, Kentucky in 1963 with his family. His mother and father both taught at what was then Cumberland College (now University of the Cumberlands) and Chris graduated from there in 1973. Coming to Frankfort in 1972 as one of the college interns in the old Administrative Intern Program, Chris continued to work for Kentucky state government, primarily for Kentucky Deferred Comp, where he served as Communications and Marketing Coordinator until his retirement in 2003. He soon returned in a part-time capacity and continued to work until 2017.

Chris is an award-winning short-story writer and the author of the novels *Yard Man*, *Dancing on the Rim*, *Violets for Sergeant Schiller*, *The White Jamaican*, *Into the Wilderness*, and *Looking at Kansas* (Wings ePress), *One More Round* (short story collection-Trajecto-

ry Press), *Snapshot* (novel-Livingston Press), *Whose Name I Did Not Know* (novel-Hopewell Publications), and *Claw Hammer* (short story collection-Hopewell Publications). Helvey currently serves as Editor-in-Chief of *Trajectory Journal*. Chris and Gina Harris have been married for almost 30 years and have three sons and five granddaughters. They live in Frankfort.

Of the things we think, say or do...

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
