She has worked in child services and the healthcare industry for more than a decade, identifying and helping to remove social determinant of health barriers. Through her role as Director of the Workforce Recovery Program with the Kentucky Chamber Foundation, Morgan works directly with businesses to focus on economic stability for individuals in recovery and with justice history, leading barriers for individuals who experience disparities. Morgan received her undergraduate degree in Sociology from Morehead State University and currently resides in Perry County, supporting local non-profits through multiple committee and volunteer opportunities.



**Kirk**

The Kentucky Chamber Foundation has developed and cultivated programs that are working to address root causes of the work-

force crisis. This presentation will focus on workforce issues and solutions, as well as an overview of the innovative initiatives at the Kentucky Chamber Foundation including the Talent Pipeline Management Program (TPM) and the Workforce Recovery Program (WRP). TPM is a statewide program that engages employers by working with them to project their short and long-term workforce needs, form and participate in industry collaborative, and establish relationships with education and workforce development partners. WRP was created to support businesses as they focus on creating a fair-chance environment with valuable training, information, and resources to foster those fair-chance employment opportunities for individuals who are ready to re-enter the workforce.

The Frankfort Rotary Club Board voted to not hold the International Dinner on April 28. Instead, there will be a special program at noon on Wednesday, April 27 at the Capital Plaza Hotel.
