Polio Plus Update

From our Director of International Service, Bill Miller:

“On behalf of our Rotary Club’s International Service Committee, a special ‘thanks’ for your past and future support to improve the Frankfort community and the world. As President Diane mentioned, we have one more project that needs our immediate assistance in securing \$1,500 to meet our Polio Plus annual goal for Rotary International.

“Due to the generous donations of millions of Rotarians, we are just on the cusp of achieving the largest and most difficult international health project – the elimination of the dreaded polio virus. Our Frankfort Club has a commitment to donate \$1,500 this year. The board has requested that each Rotarian make a voluntary contribution of \$25 or more to help achieve our Polio Plus goal.
