Fellow Rotarian **Teena Halbig** is a U of L graduate with a B.S. degree plus a Certificate in Medical Technology and board certified as MT(ASCP) but retired. She has 20 years of experience in the medical field as a U of L researcher pioneering in cytogenetics. She then worked at Jewish Hospital as a microbiologist, where the Chief Pathologist sent her to train in virology at CDC to set up the lab and supervise. Later, she would work in cancer research, pioneering in Autologous Bone Marrow Transplantation for the first transplant in Kentucky in U of L Pediatric Hematology/Oncology.

Teena is a new Rotary Club of Frankfort member but is not new to the works of Rotary. Bill Miller finally recruited Teena! Several Rotarians are UNA-USA Kentucky Division

Officers where Teena is the current Vice President and former President six years.

In 1991, Teena began her civic endeavors and clean water advocacy as co-founder of Floyds Fork Environmental Association when an excavator wanted to remove a 52-acre island in the creek across from their home. Teena was able to initiate a protective overlay for the watershed which is still in place today. Due to her interest in government, she became president of the League of Women Voters (LWV) of Louisville, then president of LWV of Kentucky. Mayor Greg Fischer has appointed her as one of 15 to be on the South Floyds Fork Vision Plan.

In 2018, UNA-USA KY Division board member John Rashid Kibonge asked Teena to help get Water for Goma, a city in the Congo dealing with catastrophic water problems. Collaborating with WaterStep, the first water station began operating there in January 2020. Now there are three water stations – but the need is great for a total of 26 water stations at each of the 26 Health Districts. Thus, if Rotary District of Frankfort would like to support a Rotary District Grant plus a Rotary Global Grant, UNA-USA KY Division and WaterStep would appreciate Rotary taking the lead to



move faster to help thousands in Goma have access to cleaner water for better health. Teena will give a slide presentation Aug. 3 to Rotary Club of Frankfort and then to the ISC on zoom Aug. 10 to provide details.
