Next Week's Meeting...

Fred Cowan, a member of the Rotary Club of Louisville, has had a distinguished career in public service. After graduating from Dartmouth College, Fred was a Peace Corps volunteer in Ethiopia, which initiated his lifelong interest in international affairs. Upon his graduation from Harvard Law School, Fred returned to his hometown of Louisville. Shortly after beginning the practice of law, Fred was elected to the Kentucky House of Representatives. After three terms he was elected Attorney General of the Commonwealth, where he spearheaded efforts to deal with election fraud, drunk driving, domestic violence, and government corruption. In 2006, he ran for and was elected Circuit Judge for the 30th Judicial District, where he served until his retirement. He thus earned the distinction of being perhaps the only Kentuckian in modern times to be elected to all three branches of Kentucky state government.

Fred has been active in the Rotary Club of Louisville for about 15 years. He is the 6710 District Peace Fellows subcommittee chair and a member of the District International Service Committee. Recently, through the efforts of Bill Miller and others, he helped initiate Partnering for Peace in Kentucky, a collaboration between Rotarians and the Peace Corps community.
