Dr. Ronald A. Johnson, PhD is the interim president of Kentucky State University. He is an innovative higher education executive skilled in leading organizations to crystallize their vision and develop strategic pathways and catalytic partnerships that amplify academic, research, and fundraising success and strengthen operating effectiveness and impact. He is motivated by a fundamental belief that higher education is about transforming lives and igniting new possibilities for the betterment of the world.



Johnson

Dr. Johnson left footprints of significant transformation and the attainment of long-term goals in higher education, portfolio management, and global financial markets based on diverse perspectives drawn from leadership experiences in tailoring and garnering support for long-term solutions that are focused on strategic value creation and risk mitigation.

Dr. Johnson is a RAS Presidential Counsel in the Registry Advisory Service Board

Governance and Leadership Practice. The Practice is staffed with a distinguished collection of veteran college, university, and foundation presidents that advise institutional trustees and senior administrative leaders concerning the strategic direction of their institutions.

Dr. Johnson is a co-founder, advisory member, and Chair of the Development Committee of the HBCU Executive Leadership Institute at CAU. The mission of the Institute is to increase the number of qualified candidates for the presidency and cabinet-level positions at HBCUs through a program centered on the development of leadership competencies, mentorship by sitting and former HBCU presidents, and real time practice in HBCU working environments. He is a former member of the President's Advisory Board of the White House Initiative on Historically Black Colleges.

Dr. Johnson is steeped in the world of investment management, finance, and economic and financial market policy analysis. He is the former president and chief investment officer at Smith Graham & Company where he managed \$3 billion in fixed income portfolios for institutional investors. Prior to Smith Graham, he was the director of global fixed income research and senior portfolio manager for Franklin Templeton, where he managed more than \$3 billion in global fixed income assets and served as a member of the Global Strategy team. Dr. Johnson has held economist positions at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, the International Monetary Fund, and the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. Dr. Johnson earned a PhD and MA in economics from Stanford University, after completing an MBA in finance and a BA in economics from Adelphi University.
