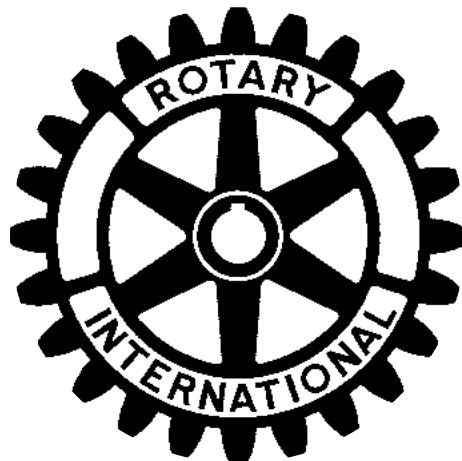

Amy Nance Snow is a Frankfort native and WHHS graduate. She has 24 years of experience working with at-risk children and youth. Her background includes therapeutic foster care, the North Carolina Department of Juvenile Justice, and Franklin County Schools.

Amy has a bachelor's degree in Corrections and Juvenile Services and a Criminal Justice master's degree from ECU. She credits her

volunteer work during the early years of The Kings Center as the experience that created her passion for program development in underserved communities. Amy started the summer feeding program at the Capital Mobile Home trailer park seven years ago and today it thrives as a non-profit run by Kathy Pauley, known as the Pavilion Foundation.
