

#### **Next Week's Meeting... Shelley Hearn** and **Tricia Hamilton** are Community Policing Advocates with the Frankfort Police Department and will be speaking to us next week.





After **Shelley Hearn** was named the first community policing advocate for the Frankfort Police Department two years ago, she quickly confirmed what she already knew — that the position was sorely needed. The first year in the role, Hearn had more than 365 contacts, and, though she hasn't yet crunched the numbers for her second year, she is sure the number is higher. Hearn had been a social worker for 25 years, and her career has been intertwined with law enforcement. Hearn has said that she has always felt our community really could benefit from this position.

She is a native of Jessamine County, and has lived in Frankfort for eight years with her husband, Troy. They have two daughters. A 1995 graduate of the University of Kentucky, she has worked for the Cabinet of Health and Family Services for 25 years. She has spent the past five years serving as a social service specialist/APS consultant with the Adult Protection Branch, and she has served in roles within the cabinet such as investigations and ongoing case management with both child and adult protective services.

Other cities in Kentucky with a community policing advocate include Jeffersontown, Georgetown, Erlanger and Alexandria.

**Tricia Hamilton** is the newest Community Policing Advocate with the Frankfort Police Department, working alongside current advocate Shelley Hearn to support and connect victims and vulnerable populations to resources within our community. Tricia is a graduate of Georgetown College with a degree in Sociology. She began her career working for Child Protective Services in Franklin County. After several years of service with CPS, she left the Cabinet to become a substance use disorder counselor and then a case manager at Vital Behavioral Health. Tricia is a Frankfort native and proudly continues to live here with her husband and 7-month-old son.
