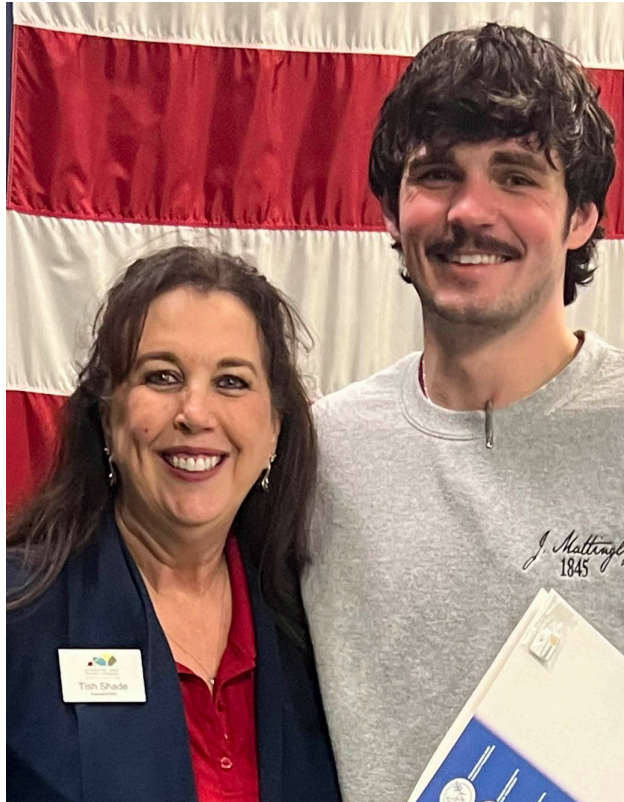


Welcome New Members!

Susan G. Zepeda is a consultant on strategic planning, change management and organizational development. Former President and CEO of the Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky (2005-2016), she advises foundations and other nonprofits on strategic planning, program evaluation, succession planning and policy advocacy. Before joining the Foundation in 2005, she was the first CEO of The HealthCare Foundation for Orange County (1999-2005) and, prior to that, Director of the San Luis Obispo County (CA) Health Agency and CEO of that County's General Hospital. She has served on numerous national and regional Boards, including Grantmakers in Health, Southeastern Council of Foundations, and the National Association for County and City Health Officials. A life-long Rotarian (since the 1980's), Susan has served as President of two different Rotary Clubs, and on the Board
