Larry W. Moore is a fourth-generation native of Frankfort, and his family roots in Kentucky precede statehood. He received a *magna cum laude* A.B. degree in humanities and psychology from Transylvania University in 1974, spent a year abroad studying the life and work of Hermann Hesse on a grant from the German Academic Exchange Service, and did graduate work in the history of sci-

ence and medicine at the University of Kentucky. He is retired from a long career in Kentucky state government, where he served in a variety of management, training, and advisory capacities, but throughout was a writer. In 2002 he co-founded Broadstone Media LLC, a cultural promotion company based in Frankfort, and in 2003 launched the publishing imprint Broadstone Books which just celebrated 20 years of operation, during which time they have published the work of over 100 authors across the United States and beyond. In 2004 he and his late wife Jane Chancellor Moore established an art gallery that now bears her name, which he continues to manage, along with serving as volunteer curator of the Grand Theater gallery in downtown Frankfort. He is a published poet, photographer, book reviewer, literary critic, and translator.
