Amelia Berry is Project Director of Just Say Yes, an innovative youth substance-use prevention coalition based at the Franklin County Health Department. Amelia came to prevention work through the arts, serving from 2018 to 2021 as founding Executive Director of Yes Arts, a non-profit working to mobilize the power of community and the arts to disrupt the cycle of addiction. In 2019, Amelia was named a Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Culture of Health Leader. Prior to returning to Kentucky in 2009, Amelia worked as a consultant in

international affairs for the United Nations, the China Law Society and the Consensus Building Institute. In 2016 Amelia was elected to the Frankfort Independent Schools Board of Education, where her six-year tenure included serving as Vice Chairperson and overseeing the district's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Amelia and her husband have two children.

Her presentation will focus on sharing highlights from the Franklin County Youth Survey that middle and high schoolers took in February.

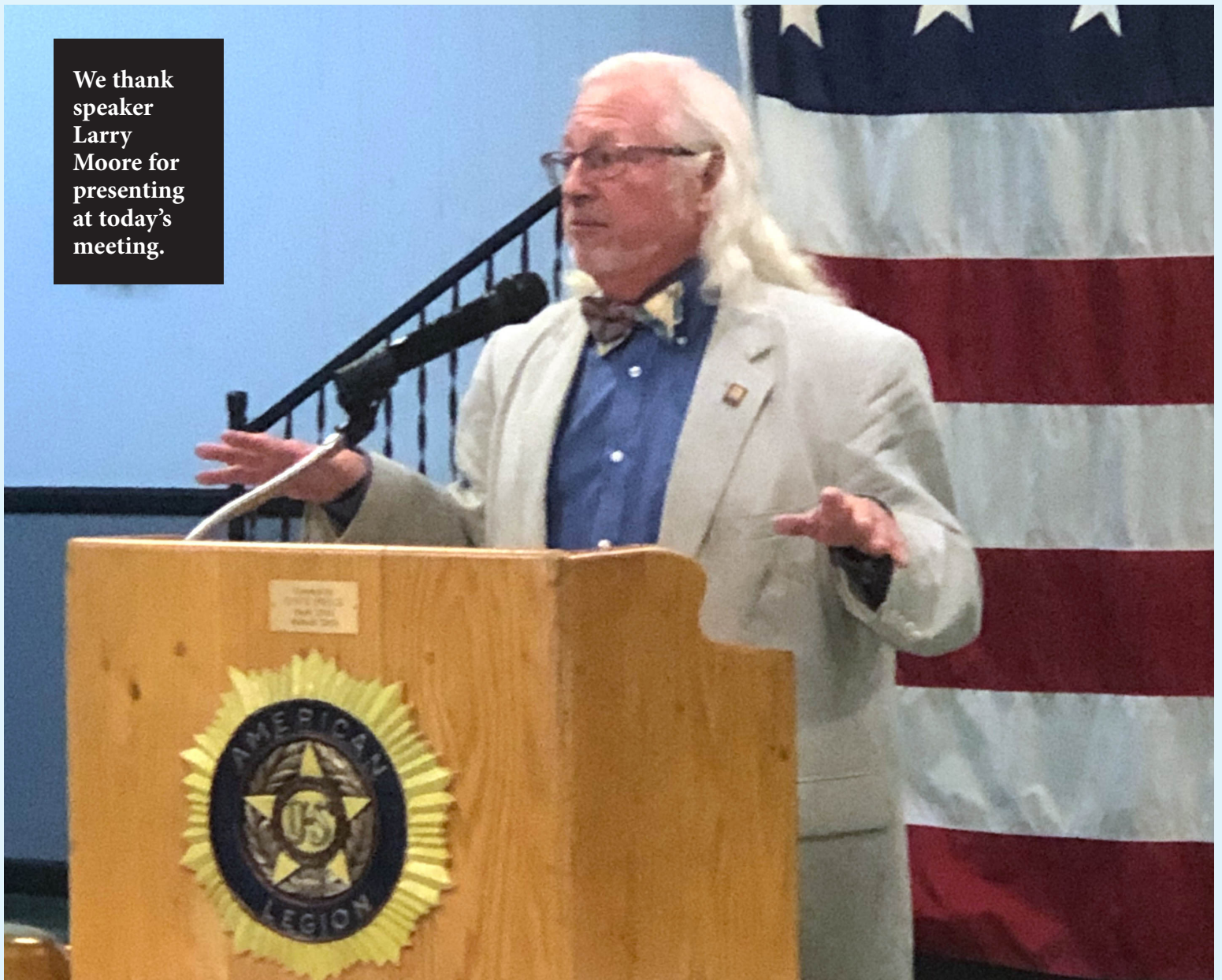
Raffle
