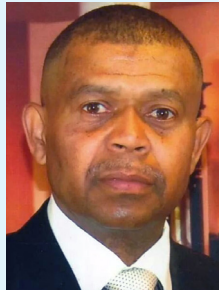

Board Action Aug. 21, 2024

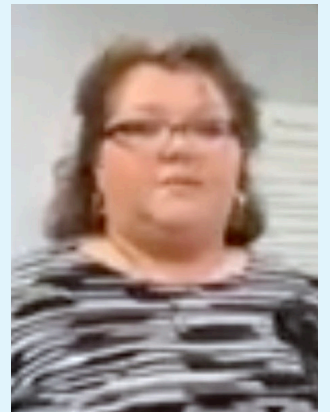
