- Approved the minutes of the Oct. 16, 2024 board meeting; Miranda Marston made the motion, second by George Gill.
- Board decided to have a spaghetti supper for a fundraiser on January 14, 2025 at the American Legion from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.
