Tommy Haynes is the executive director of the Frankfort Resource Office for Social Ministries (ROSM), a non-profit agency founded in 1982 to support individuals and families in Franklin County who require assistance with essential needs such as rent, utilities, and medicine. Through partnerships with local churches, agencies, businesses, and governments, ROSM offers hope and resources to those facing challenges.

By collaborating with various contributors, ROSM helps individuals and families overcome obstacles and work towards sustainability. Their cooperative efforts provide a vital support system for the community, offering a place for those in need to turn to for assistance and guidance.

A Nashville native, Haynes has lived in Frankfort for over 25 years. He served in the U.S. Army for 20

years, then was hired by the Kentucky Department of Education for an executive manager's position. He retired from state government in 2007. Haynes has been on the board of eight different organizations in the community. He served three terms as a Frankfort city commissioner, with two terms as mayor pro-tem.
