

Though she doesn't take credit, she applauds the community of coming together, donating and trusting her with distribution.

Waldridge holds level 3 City official status with Kentucky League of Cities. She embraces continuing education as a proud graduate two times from THE Kentucky State University, she makes it a priority to gain the skills and knowledge to be the best Official/ voice she can be for the community while making the best decisions now and for the future of Frankfort. She continues to be a tireless advocate for positive change in Frankfort, striving to create a city where diversity is celebrated, and

everyone has a voice in shaping its future.

She is not sure where she will land next, but she shared that this time is being used wisely and she will continue to support our community, KSU, small businesses and organizations however she can.
