### Next Week's Meeting...


The captain of UK's 1978 National Championship Team will be our speaker at next week's meeting. **Jack "Goose" Givens** is a former professional basketball player known for his legendary time with the Kentucky Wildcats, where he led the team to the 1978 NCAA Championship and was named the Final Four's Most Outstanding Player. In the championship game against Duke, Givens famously scored 41 points. Jack was named to the first team all-SEC three times and was a consensus second team All-American in 1978. He finished his four-year UK career with 2,038 points, ranking third on the all-time list behind Dan Issel and Kenny Walker. His #21 jersey was retired and hangs from the rafters at Rupp Arena.

Following his standout college career, the Atlanta Hawks selected Jack 16th overall in the 1978 NBA draft, and he played for the team for two seasons before continuing his career overseas in Japan. Since retiring from playing, Givens has become a television and radio analyst for basketball, including for the UK Sports Network, and recently released a memoir titled *They Call Me Goose*. Jack will bring copies with him for sale (\$38 for hardback, \$28 for paperback).
