



Some Rotary Facts

- RYLA, or Rotary International Youth Leadership Awards, is a leadership program for young people aged 14 to 30.
- In 1985, Rotary International launched its PolioPlus program to immunize all of the world's children against polio.
- Rotary International is governed by a board of directors composed of the international president, the president-elect, the general secretary, and 17 zone directors.
- Clubs originally were limited to a single club per city, municipality, or town, but Rotary International has encouraged the formation of one or more additional clubs in the largest cities when practical.
- In 2019, Rotaract went from being a program of Rotary International to being a membership type of Rotary International, elevating its status to resemble that of Rotary clubs.
- Rotary International has worked with the UN since the UN started in 1945.
- Clubs such as Rotary International were predated by women's service organizations, which started in the United States as early as 1790.
- The first female to be President of Rotary International will be Jennifer E Jones of the Windsor Roseland Rotary Club in Windsor, Ontario Canada.
